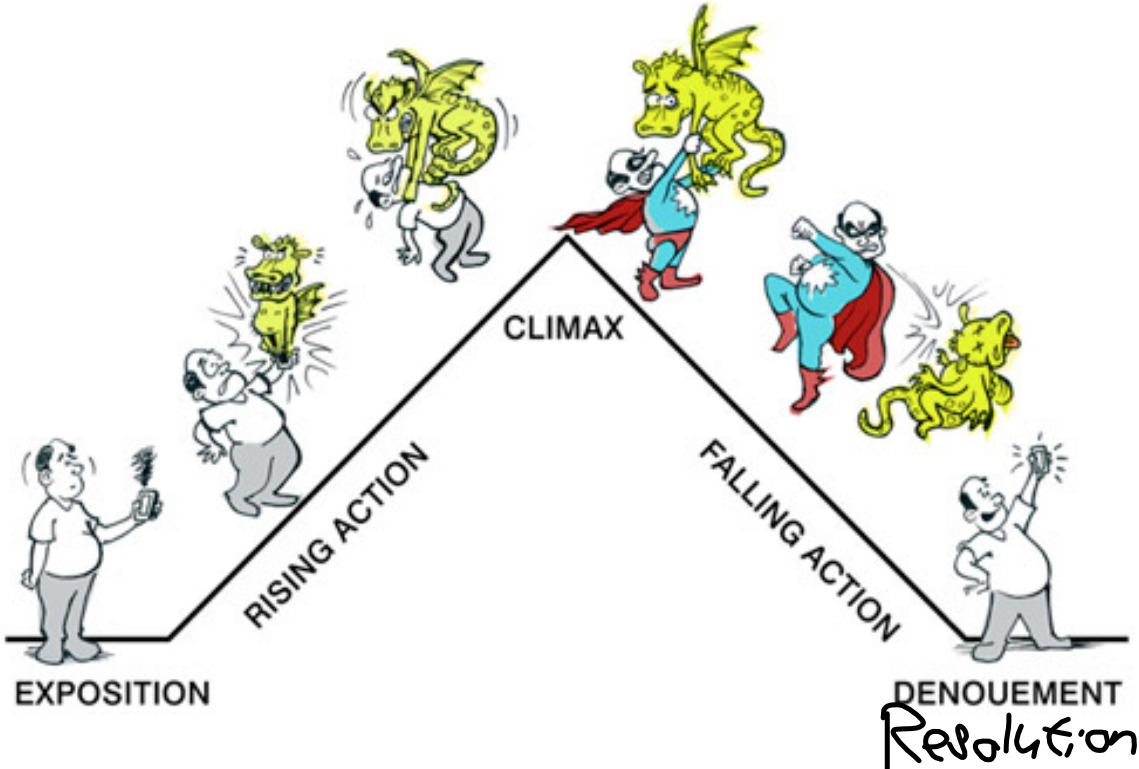
Conflict: Two Sides going against each other.

Plot: The Pattern of events in a Story

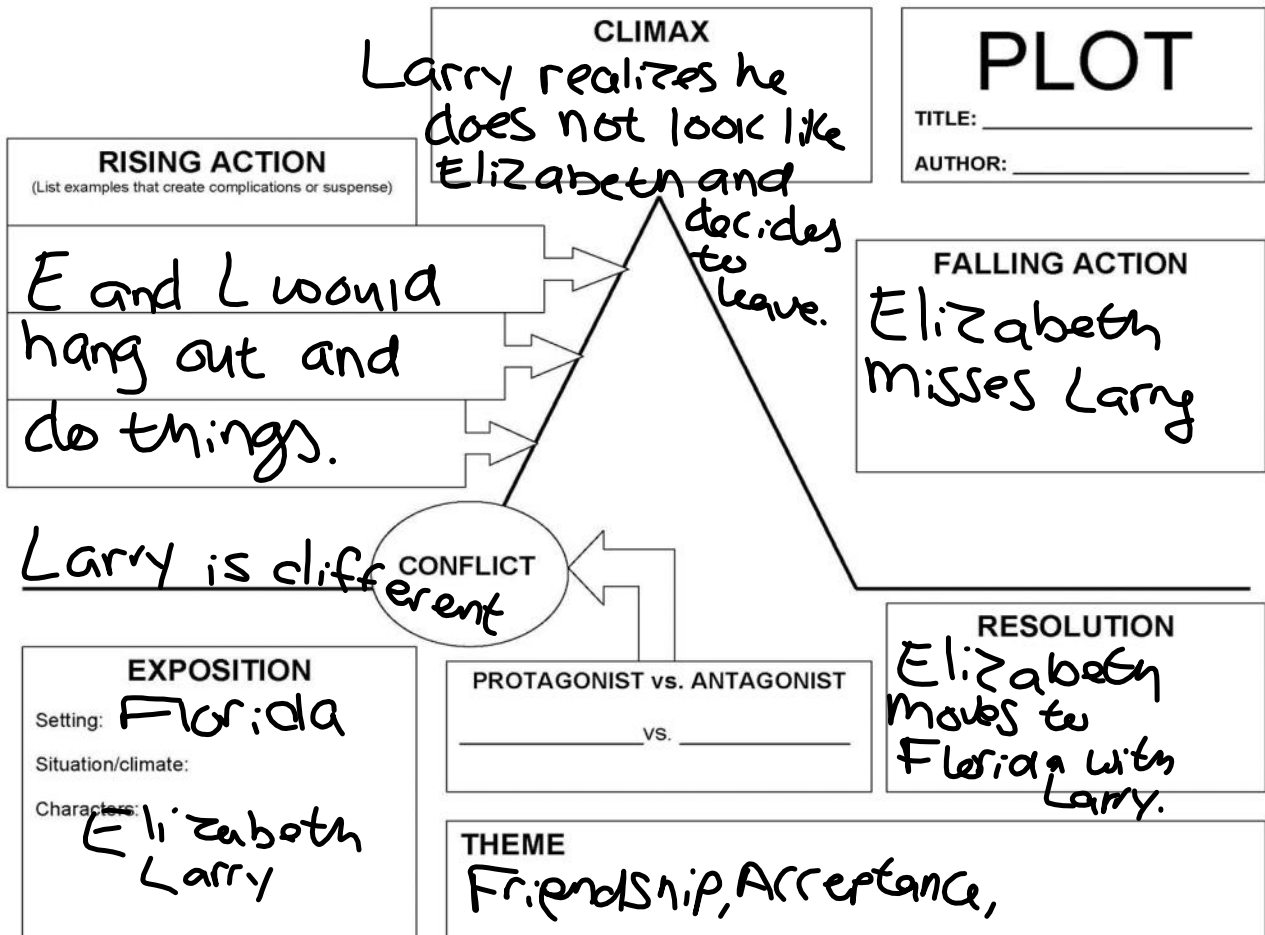
Setting: Time and Place of a Story.
